

YOUR COVID VACCINATION APPOINTMENT

Dear Patient

We are now starting to invite patients in for the COVID vaccination. If you have already been invited please make a note below of your appointment date and time, if you have not yet been invited please bear with us and when we are clear on the next supplier vaccines we will be in touch. As a reminder vaccinations are being done in age groups.

Your vaccine will take place at HEALD GREEN VILLAGE HALL (details below) NOT at the GP Practice.

It is really important that you try to arrive as close to your appointment time as possible

What to expect on the day:

1. You will be greeted outside Heald Green Village Hall and asked some health screening questions to ensure you are not currently carrying Coronavirus
Please do NOT attend your appointment if you have developed a fever, a new continuous cough or a loss of smell. Please wear a face covering at all times.
2. You will be queuing up outside, please ensure you are wearing warm clothing that is easily removable ready to have your vaccination when you come inside.
Please ensure you keep at least 1-2m away from people who are not within your household support bubble.
3. You will be taken into a consultation room for your vaccination, where the clinician will do some checks to make sure it is OK for you to have the vaccination and will confirm that you wish to proceed. The vaccination will be given as an injection into your upper arm.
4. After your vaccination, you will move to another room where you will wait along with other patients for a 15 minute observation period, after which you are free to go.
If, due to mobility issues, you require to be vaccinated in your car you must still wait for 15 minutes before you can be driven home.

YOUR COVID VACCINATION APPOINTMENT

What to expect after your vaccination:

Common side effects include an aching arm, headaches, aching muscles, fatigue & mild flu-like symptoms. These symptoms usually last less than a week. The vaccine CANNOT cause coronavirus, nor make you infectious to other people.

We do not yet know how quickly immunity is achieved with this vaccine, and as such you should continue to follow social distancing and good hand washing.

If you are a woman of childbearing age, you should avoid trying to get pregnant for at least 2 months after your second vaccination.

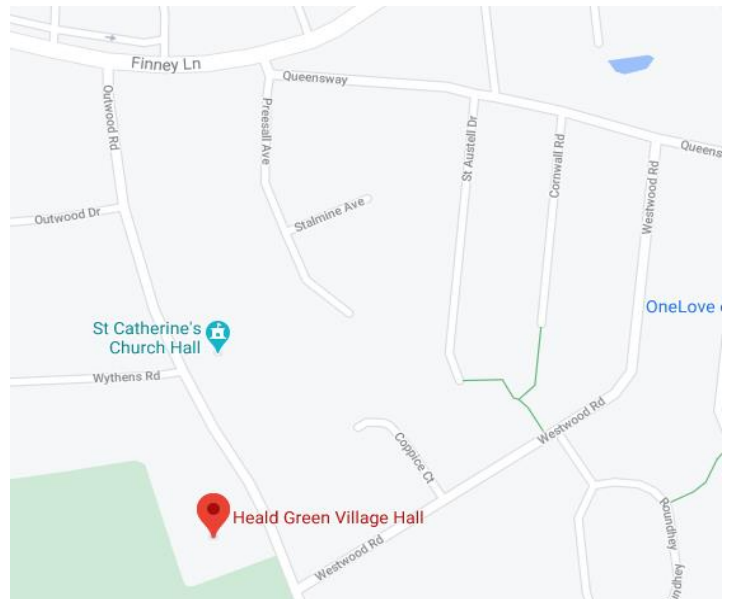
